## **Monitoring and Evaluation**

These points will help you consider the types of information that you will potentially be asked for by a funder. They are based on the National Occupational standards for the Voluntary Sector.

- 1. You are committed to reviewing your own work How do you do this?
- 2. You reflect regularly on your own and others' experiences, and use these to inform future activities
- 3. You take ownership of issues and their resolution how do you solve problems?
- 4. You seek to improve the performance and potential value of what you provide to your members and volunteers/leaders
- 5. You are committed to learning and to the sharing of experience with others
- 6. You focus on results, and take personal responsibility for making things happen
- 7. You take pride in the quality of your work
- 8. You gather and manage information effectively, efficiently and ethically
- 9. You check the validity and reliability of information you use or keep
- 10. You ensure that methods of evaluation are meaningful to your members, volunteers/leaders and anyone you work with
- 11. You present information clearly, concisely, accurately, and in a manner that promotes understanding
- 12. You analyse and structure information to develop knowledge that can be shared, through training and other means such as local meetings
- 13. You are able to make a critical evaluation of arguments, assumptions, concepts and data, and to challenge constructively
- 14. You carry out tasks with due regard to the BB policies and procedures, including those covering health and safety and child protection
- 15. You give people opportunities to provide feedback and you respond appropriately
- 16. You give feedback to others in a caring way to help them improve the experience for the members and others.
- 17. You recognise recurring problems and promote changes to structures, systems and processes to resolve these
