## QUEST

### Guidance Notes and rules

Thank you for your participation in this new Scotland-wide challenge.

Below are the guidance and rules for each of the 17 challenges. Please note that each challenge should be undertaken by a minimum of **four members** (in any age group) of your company. Evidence of your company's entry should be in photograph, sound clip or video format (apart from number nine) Please ensure that you have the necessary permissions and have undertaken relevant risk assessments. Entries and any questions should be emailed to [yoyp2018@boys-brigade.org.uk](mailto:yoyp2018@boys-brigade.org.uk) You can also call Scottish HQ for support on 01324 562008 (option 1).

Winners will be decided from the completed entries by a panel made up from the YoYP youth advisory group and members of the Scotland committee. Their decision will be final. Winners of *Quest* will receive the Simon Smith Trophy. Should more than one company complete **Quest** successfully, the judges will look base their decision on the amount of creativity and youth involvement.

Entries should be submitted by **Friday 26<sup>h</sup> April 2019** Oh, and keep an eye out for bonus challenges too!

#### 1. Fountain or waterfall

- i. You might have to seek this one out, but go find a waterfall or fountain and take a group photograph

#### 2. VOICE

- i. Invite a MP, MSP or a MSYP to your event or activity – you could even host a question time

#### 3. Summit

- i. Group to climb to summit of a hill or mountain and take a group photograph

#### 4. Scene from Bible

- i. Recreate a story from the Bible
- ii. Scene should be videoed
- iii. last no longer than **one minute**

#### 5. Selfie

- i. Self-explanatory – take a whole-section/company selfie!

#### 6. BIG Brunch

- i. Take part in the BB Scotland BIG Bruch event <https://boys-brigade.org.uk/events/event/big-bb-brunch/>
- ii. OR, organised a youth-led community event (This can also be any form of 'social action', such as fundraising / helping others / campaigning )

#### 7. Your Church

- i. Arrange a youth-led/involved joint BB & Church Event - be it a church service, parade, outreach event, etc.

- ii. OR, undertake an event with the local Guild (BB is a partner of the Church of Scotland Guild for the next three years) Find out more about our partnership with the Guild <https://boys-brigade.org.uk/scotland/guildpartnership/>

#### 8. New activity

- i. It has been included in any resource section of **Gazette or OBM**
- ii. Introduce new sport or game to at least one section of your company

#### 9. #YoYP2018

- i. Your social media challenge - Share photo, video or even live video to Instagram or twitter which uses and encapsulates the 'Year of Young People' hashtag **#YoYP2018**

#### 10. STEM

- i. Undertake a least one STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Maths) programme idea  
(Looking for inspiration? Try this <https://www.stem.org.uk/>)

#### 11. Body language

- i. Spell out a message using bodies and take a photograph

#### 12. 20km Challenge

- i. Cover a distance over land or water by foot, cycle or boat (as a group)
- ii. No motorised transport permitted
- iii. Take group photo of your challenge

#### 13. BB family

- i. Undertake an event, activity or project with at least one other BB company
- ii. This could be done either in person or virtually (ie. BB Global)

#### 14. Bring a Friend

- i. Arrange a 'bring a friend' or a similar recruiting event – involve young people in the planning.

#### 15. Takeover!

- i. Invite young people in the section or company to decide the programme for a night

#### 16. Castle

- i. Build a favourite Scottish castle or palace using lego, or food (like using spaghetti, marshmallows, etc.)

#### 17. Jingle

- i. Create a jingle or song saying what you enjoy most about The Boys' Brigade
- ii. Jingle should be last no longer than 30 seconds
- iii. Track should be recorded or videoed
