Refund Policy

Withdrawal, including transfer to another course:

- less than 8 days prior to commencement of a course will result in the loss of 100% of the course fee;
- 8-14 days prior to commencement of a course will result in the loss of 75% of the course fee;
- 15-28 days prior to commencement of a course will result in the loss of 50% of the course fee.

Note: During this time of uncertainty around Covid-19, if a course is cancelled we will transfer participants to the next available course.

Eligibility

Young people can participate in a Completion Residential:

- (a) no earlier than the session equivalent to Year 13
- (b) not less than 12 months from the date of registration; and
- (c) not less than 6 months from the completion of Skills for Queen's Badge training.

Notes

Maximum of 8 candidates per Company per course.

If 1st choice course is full, captain will be notified that they have been allocated their 2nd choice course.

Confirmation of places booked will be sent <u>by email</u> <u>only</u> – to the Captain if an address is supplied.

A place will not be confirmed until HQ has received a registration, consent form and payment for each young person.

Queen's Badge Record Books

You don't need to send record books to Newport at the time of registration. Instead, the Captain needs to sign registration forms to confirm all aspects are or will be complete by commencement of the course.

Candidates must bring their record books to the course.

Badges & Certificates

Queen's Badges will be issued automatically after successful completion of a Queen's Badge Residential. This is included in the course fee. Badges do not need to be applied for separately.
