PREPARATION NEEDED

SETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Create a mini campfire in the garden using just a few basic materials.

- You'll need appropriate tinder materials. Tinder is small, dry and highly flammable materials to help catch the flame. A natural tinder would be dry grass, however if you can't find that then cotton wool will work.
- Place a foil tray on an appropriate surface (it may burn surface underneath). Inside build a fire by creating a small pile of dry sticks. Leave a gap near the bottom to place your tinder.
- Fill a bucket of water and have this to hand for when you need to extinguish the fire.
- 4) Using matches or a lighter carefully ignite your tinder. Gently blow on the flame to boost the oxygen and grow the flame. This should help light the small pile of sticks.
- 5) Manage the fire by ensuring there is enough fuel (sticks). Once finished, carefully extinguish the fire with a bucket of water.

- Tin Foil TrayBucket of Water
- Dry Sticks & Wood
- Dry Grass or Cotton Wool
