GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Take a butterfly on a journey around your local area, watching as the patterns and colours of its wings change with the nature around you.

You'll need to print out the butterfly template at the bottom of this pack or draw your own. Stick this to a piece of cardboard and then ask a grown-up to cut out the wings of the butterfly, leaving a hole in the cardboard where the wings used to be.

Now, with a grown-up, take a walk around your local area looking for bits of nature that have interesting patterns or bright colours. When you find something, hold your butterfly nature frame in front of it and the butterfly's wings should now be full of the flowers, leaves or whatever else you have found. Take a photo of that frame and then carry on finding new colours and patterns.

After your walk, take a look through all the photos you have taken and select your favourite three. Send these to your BB group or post on social media using #BBatHOME.
