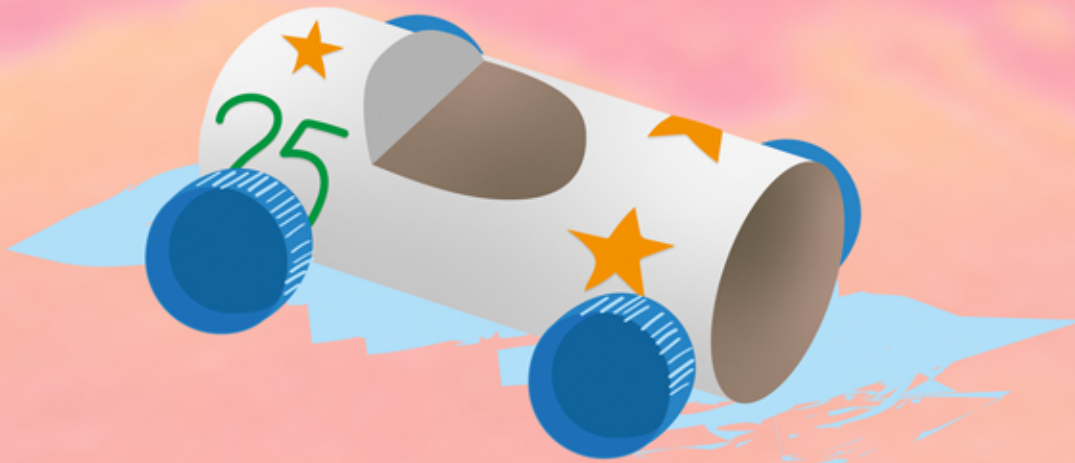


TOILET ROLL RACING CARS

GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Build a racing car from a toilet roll tube ready to race around the home. Perfect to celebrate the return of Formula 1 racing.

- 1) Colour or paint a toilet roll tube. This will be the body of your car so think about what colours and patterns you wish to use.
- 2) Ask a grown-up to carefully cut a small hole in the top of the car. This will be where your racing driver (Lego figure) can sit.
- 3) Attach four wheels to the car. The best thing to use is bottle tops, but you could cut out a piece of cardboard. If a grown-up is able to, then you could make a hole into each bottle top and connect the wheels using cocktail sticks so they roll, alternatively just stick or glue these onto the tube.

Once designed and built, build a racetrack out of toys and then race your car around, just like they do in F1 Racing.



WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Toilet Roll Tube
- 4 Bottle Tops
- Tape / Glue
- Colouring Pens / Paint
- Scissors
- Lego Figure
