➔ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Come up with an inventive and fun way to raise money for your BB or for a charity of your choice.

To begin with, think about which charity or cause you'd like to raise money for. You may wish to look at different charities or you may want to raise money for a project / trip / activity at BB.

You'll need to think about what fundraising activity to take on. Currently there are quite a few restrictions on the type of activity you can do, so you'll need to consider a virtual event, such as a sponsored walk / climb etc or something you can do at home.

Think about what materials you'll need to promote and complete your fundraiser. This could include sponsored forms, social media graphics, an article in the local newspaper / church newsletter etc. With help from leaders, could you also set up an online giving page to help people donate?
