## ▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

The people who collect the bins do a brilliant job, although are some of the keyworkers who get the least amount of thanks. Help change that by creating a card and small gift to leave for the bin collectors next time they visit your street.

**Card:** Create a thank you card or message. On it create a colourful image and a message of thanks.

**Gift:** Leave a treat for them too. This might be a small chocolate bar or bag of sweets or you might bake some cookies or cupcakes for them.

Leave your card and gift on top of, or by, the bin next time it's bin day. Make sure you place it in a bag or container and it's well labelled, so it doesn't get thrown away. Alternatively wait for them to come down your street and give it to them yourself (ensuring you follow social distancing guidelines).

Ask a grown-up to take a photo of your card and gift and share it with your BB group or post on social media using #BBatHOME.
