GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

A game which gets children hunting around the house for a unique item no one else will think of.

This game is an adaptation of the find me game. Children should be given a category and given a minute to hunt around the house for something that fits the category. When they return they should keep the item hidden until the time is up.

All at the same time, everyone should reveal their item. Points can be awarded to anyone who brings back a unique item. Anyone who brings back an item that someone else has, should score zero points.

Categories could include kitchen utensils, stationery items, clothes, fruit, DVDs, chocolate bars, BB badges, colours, numbers etc. For smaller groups you may wish to make the category more defined e.g. utensils to cutlery or clothes to types of hat.

Continue playing for a few rounds, keeping the score as you go along. The person with the most points at the end of the game wins.

KEEPING EVERYONE SAFE

Ask children to only bring back items which are sensible and safe to do so. Encourage children to walk when collecting the items, rather than running around the house.
