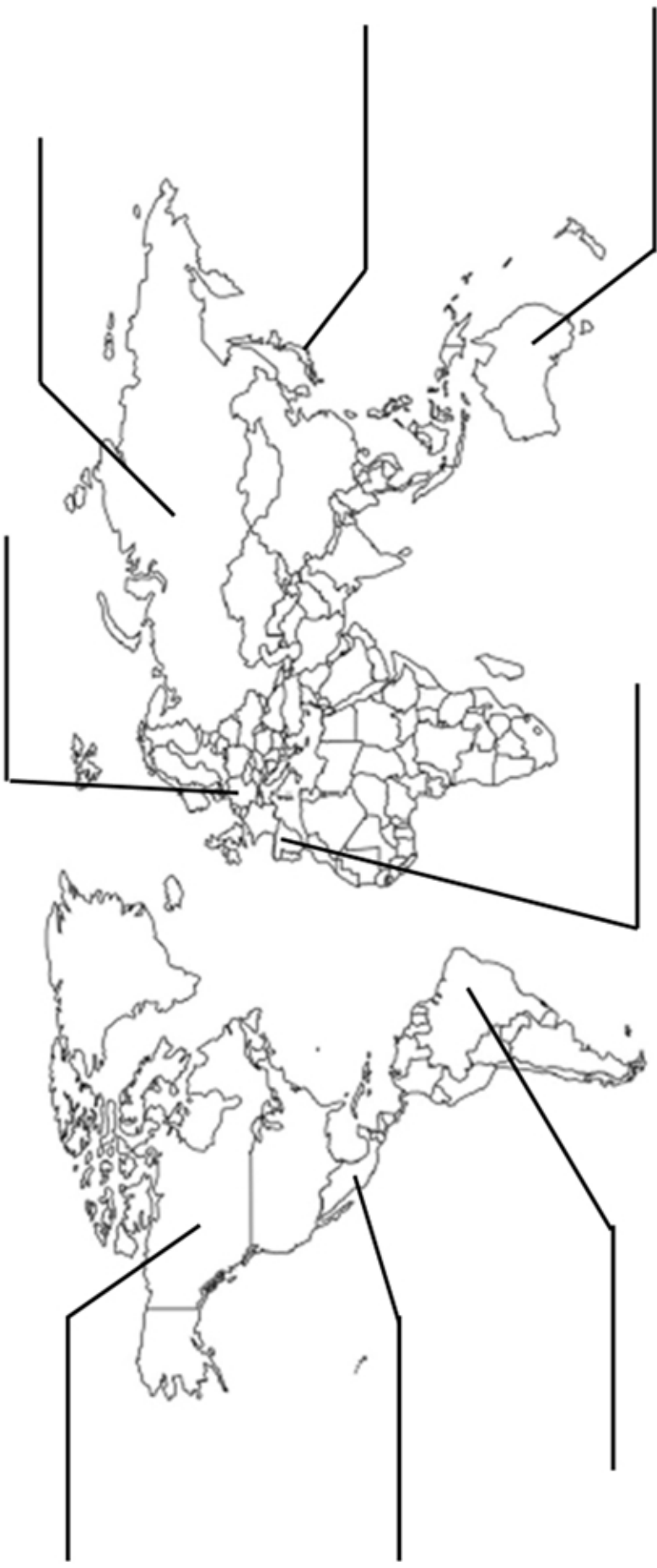
## ! NOTES FOR PARENTS & CARERS
