WHAT I DID THIS SUMMER



▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

It's been a while since we were last together. Spend time catching up with each other and sharing what adventures you've been on.

Print out a map of the UK and also a map of your local town / city. You may also want a map of Europe, should some of your group have been on holiday abroad.

One at a time, ask each child to share what they have been up to over the summer. You may also want to include the time since your BB group last met. Whilst going around the group, give opportunities for children to ask questions about each other's adventures.

For each adventure, let the group mark on the map where they have been. You could use different coloured pens for different children. Once everyone has had a go, you'll be able to look at the map and see all the different places the group have been to.

Did any children complete any of the 20 summer adventures set by The Boys' Brigade UK & ROI?

Virtual Session: A leader could have the maps printed out. Alternately use screenshare and the annotate option to draw directly onto the map whilst on Zoom.
