#### **GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY**

An observation game designed to develop and encourage observation skills. How quickly can you spot all 15 differences?

For this activity, you'll need to download and print the 'Autumn Spot the Difference' activity sheet. Alternatively, you could show the image on a large projector screen.

Children should look at both images, trying to spot all 15 differences. If using printed sheets, they can circle the difference with a pen. If using a projector, then they should be encouraged to put their hand up when they have a difference they wish to share with the group.

How many differences can the group spot? Can someone find all 15? Spend time together afterwards, highlighting all the differences to the group, so they can find any they missed.

**Take it Further:** Continue with this style of activity by searching online for more autumn worksheets. These could be wordsearches, colouring sheets, treasure maps, I Spy and so on.

**Virtual:** Share the image using screenshare and encourage children to find the differences. This could be done individually or as a group.
