THE LEAFY LION

PART OF THE AUTUMN THEMED PROGRAMME



▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Get creative with some autumn leaves, by creating your very own leaf lion.

In preparation, you'll need to download and print the lion face template (one lion face per child). A leader may want to pre-cut the lion faces too. You'll also need to collect a pile of dry autumn leaves.

Each child should colour in their lion face using colouring pens / pencils. Once complete they will need to cut out the face (if not already done for them).

Then each child should spread a generous layer of glue over a blank piece of white card/paper. The glue should cover most of the sheet. Children can then start sticking the leaves onto the sheet. These leaves will form the mane for the lion, so they should be fanned out to look like a lion's mane. Once all the leaves are on, apply some glue to the back of the lion's face and stick this onto the middle of the leaves. This should then bring the artwork together to show the lion's head surrounded by the lion's mane (leaves).

Take it Further: What other leaf art can the group produce? Use different leaves to create different animals.

- Lion Face Template
- White Card / Paper
- Colouring Pens/Pencils
- Leaves
- Glue
- Scissors
