GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Learn the importance of managing money, creating budgets and making decisions of where to spend your money.

Download the 'Budget Game' activity sheet. Ideally each person will need their own copy of the first 2 sheets and 25 coins or counters each (pens could be used). Go through the activity, using the instructions for each situation. For each situation you'll need to distribute your coins across your monthly budget, deciding what you will or won't spend your money on. After each situation, give time for the group to share how they have spent their money and what choices they had to make. What are the similarities and differences between the group's decisions?

Spend some time at the end talking about how you've spent your money. Have you been realistic? Did you spend the money sensibly on 'needs' rather than excessively on 'wants'. Do you think you could stick to this budget in real life, month after month?

Virtual: Share the budget sheets using screenshare. Ask the group to write down how they will spend their money and then share as a big group or in breakout rooms.

The Budget Game - How to Play

Situation 1

Everyone has a monthly salary of 25 coins. They must split their coins across the different budget areas, buying the things they want and need. Areas marked with a red explanation mark must have an option selected.

Situation 2

The economy is struggling and you've had to take a pay cut. You are now reduced down to 20 coins. You'll need to find savings in your monthly budget

Situation 3

As is normal in life, unexpected costs and problems arise. Ask each person in turn to call out a number between 1 and 10. Read out the statement that matches that number. That person will then need to explain how they are going to respond to the situation.

- 1) You've had to take a 2 coin pay reduction. Decide where you'll make savings
- 2) Your rent / mortgage has increased this year. If you are living at home, do nothing. If you have rented or brought your own place, take off 2 beans from your budget.
- 3) Netflix, Spotify and Xbox/PlayStation have all increased their monthly costs by 1 coin each (to 2 coins). If you have purchased any of those services, decide which you'll keep (if any) and how you'll pay for them.
- 4) Your car needs new tyres. If you own a car, find 2 coins from your budget to pay for it.
- 5) You're getting married this year. Find 5 coins from your monthly budget to pay for it.
- 6) You've had a pay rise. Add 3 coins to your budget.
- 7) You have a new job and you need a suit for it. Find 2 coins to pay for this.
- 8) Your boiler has broke. If you live away from parents, find 3 coins to pay for this.
- 9) You've been invited by your friends to join them on a week away to Ibiza. It will cost 3 coins. Decide if you'll go and if so, how you'll find the money.
- 10) Inflation has hit your bills hard. You can't continue to keep paying for everything. Find a saving of 3 coins.
