# LASER EYES



## GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Can the detective find 'laser eyes' before they take out the whole group?

Ask everyone to stand in a space in the room (socially distanced where required). One person should be nominated the detective. They should close their eyes whilst a leader points out who is going to have 'laser eyes'. The detective can open their eyes again.

Start the game by asking everyone to carefully walk around, going in different directions and changing directions throughout. This must be at walking pace to ensure social distancing is maintained.

The person with laser eyes should make eye contact with people as they walk around and discreetly blast them with their laser eyes (this can be done by winking or nodding). If a child is hit by the lasers, they should fall to the floor and then make their way to the side of the room. The detective's job is to walk around and try to spot who has laser eyes. The detective is allowed up to 2 guesses. Can the detective catch laser eyes before most of the players have been hit?

Continue to play, with new detectives and laser eyes nominated for each round.
