# MY VOICE, MY VOTE



## ➔ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Have a say in your programme and then have a debate and vote on what to do. Link with UK Parliament Week (1<sup>st</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> November 2020).

This activity is all about you as a group coming up with different ideas for what you could do together. The activity can work based on an amount of money being available (i.e £50-£100) that you could spend on activities, equipment, trips etc or by asking your leaders to hand over one of your meeting nights (time), so you to decide what happens that evening. Either way you will need to have some discussion with your leaders as to how this will work, but only one group's suggestion will take place. As a large group you'll need to debate and vote on which option is best.

**Small Groups:** In small groups, have a chat about what you'd like to do. Discuss different options and use your negotiation skills to get your idea selected. For virtual sessions, use breakout rooms for this.

**Pitches:** Come together as a big group and pitch the ideas. Take questions afterwards from the rest of the group.

**Debate:** Hold a debate about the best use of the money / time. Groups can now argue for/against other ideas too.

**Vote:** Finally hold a vote for which idea should be chosen as the winner. To make it fair, you can't vote for your own idea.
