GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

'Who am I?' Game: Give someone a post-it note with a famous name on. Let them ask yes / no questions to try and find out who they are. Who can discover their identity in the least questions?

In this game, our job is to find our identity by asking important questions. Sometimes our questions lead to dead ends and other times they lead to breakthroughs which enable you to look at your identity differently.

Exploring Christianity is also about asking important questions. Questions such as 'Who am I?' 'Am I a good person?' 'How should I live my life?' 'Does God love me?'. When we ask these questions to the right people, when we turn to God in prayer or open our Bibles, only then do we start to find the answers and explore our identity and our relationship with God. Are you ready to place God first and let him shape who you are?

'Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.' (Matthew 7:7)
