REMEMBRANCE ROCKS



GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Mark remembrance by creating a remembrance themed rock for children to leave in their community, for others to find.

Each child will need a smooth rock to paint / draw on. Wash off any dirt and decorate the rock with permanent markers or paint. Make sure the images are bright and colourful and represents remembrance. This might be with poppies, soldiers, words etc. Allow the rock to dry and then finish by writing a message of remembrance on the bottom of the rock. You could also include a link to your Boys' Brigade's social media page, so people who find the rock can send you a photo.

Coat the rock in PVA glue or a sealant. This will ensure the paint / pen doesn't run in the rain if children leave them outside. If you have time, go for a walk close to your meeting location to leave the rocks for others to find or encourage the group to go for a walk at another time, with their families, to hide their rock.

Before or after the activity, spend some time looking at remembrance and why it is important. For more information about Remembrance head to www.britishlegion.org.uk

- Smooth Rock
- Paint / Paint Brush
- Permanent Marker
