GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Create a poppy, a symbol of remembrance, at home using things found around the house.

Household items: Use items from around the house to create a giant poppy on the floor. This might be from toys, books, games, shoes, cushions, clothes etc - whatever you can get your hands on. Can you get the shape and the colour right? How big will you create your poppy?

Lego: Build a poppy from Lego or similar building bricks. This might be a flat poppy or you could build a 3D model. The size and quantity of poppies is up to you!

Recycled Poppy: Use items from your recycling bin. You could use cardboard, bottles, bottle tops, yoghurt pots etc. If you have paint, then you could decorate the poppy too. Once complete, display the poppy in a window or around the house.
