







The Challenge

Ask Anchors to get creative and make a 'Jesus Love Me' plate or circle.

Anchors should put the words 'Jesus loves' at the top and then they could either write their name or their family name at the bottom and decorate the plate.



Glue

What you need

Paper plates or plain card/paper with a circle drawn on it. Colouring pencils/pens

Craft materials for decorations



Anchors can:

- draw or paint
- stick on a picture of themselves
- stick on decorations with any materials they have eg stickers, glitter, stars, foam shapes etc.
- instead of plates, a paper/card circle will do
- Alternative: make a crown with Jesus Loves Me written on it.

SIX IN SIX CHALLENGE: JESUS LOVES ME CRAFT

- 1. Use a paper plate or draw a circle on plain paper.
- 2. At the top of your plate or circle write 'Jesus Loves'.
- 3. At the bottom of your plate or circle write 'me' or your family name
- 4. Decorate your plate or circle using colouring pencils, felt tips, paint, stickers or anything from your craft box.
- 5. Ask a parent to take a picture of you with your finished plate or circle.
