



GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Head out on a group walk around your local area to explore the colourful Christmas illuminations. Can you find all the items on the Christmas lights checklist?

Encourage children to come to the session wrapped warm and dressed for the weather. Ask children to also bring a torch with them if they have one. Before leaving your venue, please explain all appropriate safety rules children will need to follow when outside.

Head out on a group walk, hunting for houses with colourful Christmas light displays. It is recommended that a leader prepare for this session by finding a suitable route beforehand, where there are a good number of houses (or shops, etc) with Christmas lights on display. Where possible, choose a route away from busy roads and hazards.

How many items on the checklist can you find? Can you find them all? Try to keep a tally of how many of each item you see on your travels. Which Christmas object is the most popular in your local area? Can you find a house which is covered top to bottom in Christmas lights?

Have fun on your travels and enjoy getting into the Christmas spirit.
