▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Become just like the Wise Men, on a mission to find stars to lead you to special treasure.

Before children arrive, hide some stars around your meeting space. This might be behind things, under tables, stuck to walls, on notice boards etc. If you are meeting outdoors or have outdoor space make it even more of an adventure, with children given torches to help find the stars (glow in the dark stars would work well for this).

Either individually or in pairs, children can hunt around the allocated space, looking for stars. When finding a star, children could collect it (competition for who can find the most stars) or you could have different coloured stars, with children having to find all the different colours (leaving the star where they found it, for others to find). Have some chocolate coins with the stars for children to collect too as treasure.

Take it Further: Speak about the Christmas star and how it guided the wise men to Baby Jesus. Just like we found treasure on our star hunt, the wise men found the best treasure possible - Jesus! These days we don't need a special star to find Jesus, he is always with us wherever we are.
