



## **GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY**

We use emojis every day to help us communicate with each other. Can you use your emoji knowledge to work out the hidden Christmas films and song titles?

Download the 'Christmas Emojis' PowerPoint ready for the activity. If meeting face-to-face, you'll need to display this so everyone can see (projector /  $\mathsf{TV}$  etc).

On the PowerPoint you'll find 15 different sets of emojis. Each line of emojis is giving clues to a famous Christmas film or song. Try to put the emojis together to work out the hidden answer. For each question there is a clue to help you out.

This game can be played by writing down your guesses and revealing the answers at the end, awarding a point for every correct answer. Another way to play could be for players to buzz in (make a noise) when they think they know the answer, receiving one point for a correct guess and losing a point for an incorrect guess. The person with the most points at the end is the winner.

**Take it further:** Try and create your own Christmas themed emoji questions. Is there a song or film not on the PowerPoint, which you could re-create using emojis? Try them out on the rest of the group.
