



# WOULD I LIE TO YOU?



## ▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Is it ever right to lie or should we always tell the truth, no matter what the consequences?

Start by playing two truths and a lie. Take it in turns to say three facts about you, two of which are true and one a lie. Others can question that person and then guess which is the lie. Continue playing until everyone has had a go. Who was the best liar? Did anyone make lying look easy?

Have a chat about the following questions. Is it ever right to lie? Is a small white lie ever justified? What was the last lie that you told? What reasons do you think people lie? (Protect themselves, hurt others, make themselves look good)

The bible is clear that lying is wrong. The small things matter to God. If we lie about little things like what time you really got off the Xbox last night or if you've had a bag of crisps before dinner, then does that start to make it easier to lie about bigger and more harmful things in the future?

God wants us to live our lives in a way that reflects him, putting our old ways like lying behind us. Read **Colossians 3 v 9-10**.
