BAUBLE RACES

GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

A twist on the classic egg and spoon race. Can you transport the bauble through the course without dropping it?

Split into teams. Each child ideally needs their own spoon and bauble. Set up an obstacle course for each team to complete. Obstacles could include climbing over objects, crawling under/through things, going through a hoop etc. Children could help design the course.

On go, one person from each team should transport their bauble using their spoon. The bauble cannot be held onto the spoon. Should it fall, the bauble must be placed back on the spoon before carrying on. Baubles should be left at the end of the course and the child should run back to their team to release the next team member onto the obstacle course. First team to get all their players and baubles to the end is the winners.

Take it further: Place a small tree at the end of the course for each team. Children should complete the obstacle course transporting baubles, stars, decorations, LED lights, tinsel etc. First team to get all the decorations to the end and on their tree wins. You could also have a competition for best decorated tree.
