# DESIGN A BAUBLE



## ▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Christmas trees look great when full of colourful decorations and baubles. Use one of the below methods to design a bauble, ready for children to hang on their trees at home.

**Cardboard Bauble:** Print the 'Design a Bauble' template onto card and cut out the bauble. Spend time decorating the shape. This could be with colouring pens, glitter, tissue paper, pom poms or any sort of craft materials. Make sure to decorate both sides of the bauble. Attach string/ribbon to the bauble, so it can then be hung on a tree.

**Paint a Bauble:** Purchase some plain baubles and decorate them using paints, pens etc. Plastic / polystyrene baubles can be purchased online from sites such as Baker Ross and Amazon.

**Fill a Bauble:** Purchase fillable plastic baubles. Children could stick a photo or picture inside or fill the shape with tissue paper, glitter, small polystyrene balls (snow), sweets or much more.

Once completed, children can take the bauble home and place it on their Christmas tree. Encourage the group to take a photo of the bauble on their Christmas tree and send the picture to the BB group.
