GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

The sky is the limit when it comes to building with Lego. Explore children's imagination with some simple building challenges.

Each child or pair will need a small pile of building bricks and a table or section of the floor to work in. Set one or more of the challenges below and encourage the group to make the best and most creative structures.

Categories: Set a category and give children 5 minutes to create a structure that best fits the category. After the time is up, let everyone show off their creations and then declare a winner for that category. Repeat the process with more categories. Categories could include a house, rocket, animal, mode of transport, food and so on.

Inventions: The group need to create a brand new invention using the bricks. It should be something brand new, but what that is / does is completely up to them. It could be a new gadget, new mode of transport, a new type of animal etc.

Virtual: For virtual sessions, ask children to come to the session with building bricks. If children don't own building bricks then they could take part using other items such as books, DVDs, toys etc, making a 2D creation laying the objects on the floor.
