# FIND THE BRICK

PART OF THE BUILDING BLOCKS THEMED PROGRAMME



## ▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Become brick detectives, hunting around for the missing bricks.  
Can you find them all?

This activity is about hunting for Lego bricks. It can be run face-to-face or virtually, using one of the methods below.

**Face-to-Face:** Hide bricks around your meeting space and challenge children, either individually or in groups, to find the bricks. This could be where children find bricks, pick them up and collect them, with the person / team collecting the most bricks as the winner. Alternatively, you could hide bricks of different colours with children trying to find all the different colours, ticking them off a sheet as they go.

**Virtual:** Use the 'Find the Brick' PowerPoint and screenshare function. Go through the PowerPoint, with each slide telling the children which brick(s) to find. Give children 60 seconds on each slide to try and find the brick. Ask children to raise their hand once they have found the brick each time.
