▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Believing in something you can't see can be difficult to do. How can we believe in a God we cannot see?

Give each child a paperclip and a cup of water. Ask them to try and make the paperclip float on the water. It should be impossible. Now ask the group 'If I told you I could make the paperclip float, would you believe me or would you want to see proof?'. Without seeing proof it's hard to believe it's possible!

Place a small square of tissue paper / kitchen roll on the water and gently place the paperclip on top. As the paper gets saturated it should sink, leaving the paperclip floating. How amazing! Do the group believe you, now they have seen it themselves?

Believing something you can't see is difficult, however that's what Christians are called to do. We can't see God, but we must trust he is there by our side looking after us. We don't need to see God to feel his presence. He can see us and hear us - we just have to have faith in him. **'Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.'** John 20:29

Virtual: Ask Children to have the equipment with them, so they can do the activity at home.

- Cup of Water
- Paperclip
- Small Square of Tissue Paper
