#### GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

50,000 children are deaf in the UK. Explore two ways to communicate with deaf people and learn some top tips on how to communicate well.

Complete one or both of the activities below, looking at different ways to communicate with deaf people. Use the experience from the activities to think about the top tips at the bottom of the card. How can you communicate better with deaf people?

Read my Lips: Lip reading is when a deaf person will watch your lip movements to work out the words. Have a go at this and see how difficult it can be. One person should put on headphones with loud music whilst someone else says different words for them to guess (e.g. items found in a supermarket). How many words can you understand in 1 minute?

Sign Language Bingo: Download the finger spelling card and the bingo sheets. Give each person a bingo card. A leader should sign the letters in a random order. Where the letter is on the bingo card, cross it off. Play for a line and then a full house.

Tips for communicating with deaf people:

- Find out how they communicate Use visual clues
- Speak clearly and naturally Don't cover your mouth
- Be patient and never give up


