

## **GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY**

Take a tour around the animal kingdom, as you listen out for and guess the noises of a wide range of animals.

Download the 'Guess the Animal Noise' PowerPoint. Use the screenshare function to share it to your virtual session. Make sure to tick the 'share computer sound' option at the bottom of the window as you share your screen.

Go through each slide, clicking on the speaker button each time to hear the animal sound. On each slide are four options which the animal could be. Ask children to guess which animal they think it is. An interactive and visual way of doing this is to get each child to point to a corner to indicate which of the options they think it might be (a leader may need to demonstrate this). You could award points for any correct guesses.

For some of the more interesting or funny sounding noises, see if any of the children would like to try and copy the animal noise. Who can do the best impression?
