READY TO GO

FIND THE RAINBOW

PART OF THE NOAH THEMED PROGRAMME



GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Hunt around the house trying to find items that make up the colours of a rainbow. Link with the story of Noah and the rainbow God sent to show his promise.

Tell the group that they are going to play the 'find me' game. For this game a leader will call out a colour and children will need to find an item around their house which matches the colour. You could award points for the quickest person back each time or the best / most interesting item.

For each round call out one of the colours of the rainbow (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, violet). Call out the colours in a random order so the group might not realise the connection. Once you have finished the game, ask the group what they notice about the colours. If you put them all together, can anyone see what it would make? A rainbow! Do they know the order of a rainbow?

Ask the group if any of them know what a rainbow has to do with the story of Noah. Ask them to share what they know and then fill in any gaps.

God sent the rainbow to show Noah his promise that he would never flood the earth again - a beautiful reminder of his protection over us.

- Household Items
