# PEOPLE WHO HELP US



## ▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Take a look at some of the jobs people do that help out our communities.

Download the 'People Who Help Us' PowerPoint and share this via screenshare. The activity involves children taking a look at 6 different roles and correctly identifying which person, vehicle, building and object belongs to each role. Drag the objects into the correct boxes for each job role. This can be done by children calling out their thoughts or it could be done by children using the annotate function to circle their guess before a leader moves the item into the box.

**Top Tip:** Don't show the PowerPoint as a presentation, instead leave it in edit mode. This will mean you can move the pictures around for the activity.

After each job title, have a think about different ways that person helps us. How many different ways can the group think of? Can the group think of any other jobs people do that help us? At the very end, ask the group 'If you were to have one of these jobs when you were older, which one would you choose and why?'

**Take it further:** Invite someone from one of these roles (or similar) to join your meeting to share what their job involves, some stories from the role and answer any questions the children may have.
