



WHERE IN THE WORLD?



GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Explore the world around you and visit up to 10 different countries - all from the comfort of your home.

This challenge will virtually take you all around the world, your job is trying to work out where you are. Download the 'Where in the World' PowerPoint and show this to the group via screenshare. Within the PowerPoint are 10 street view images. Can you use your observation skills and geography knowledge to pin on the map where you think you might be? Look around for things like landmarks, street signs, people, weather, climate etc.

After sharing the street view image for a short while, the next slide is a blank map of the world. Each person playing should draw onto the map (using the annotate function) an 'x' where they think they are in the world. Try to agree a different coloured pen for each person playing. Once everyone has had their guess, move on to the next slide where the mystery location is revealed. Whose guess was the closest? Discuss as a group why you picked the countries you did.

Points could be awarded for the closest guess or guesses each time. A forfeit could be given to the person furthest away. Who will have the most points by the end of the activity?
