LATE FOR SCHOOL



▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Why are you late for school? Dog ate your homework? Got chased by a dinosaur? To play 'Late for School' you'll need great acting skills and a good imagination!

For this drama based game, you'll need one person who is 'late for school'. They should face away from the camera. Whilst that happens, a leader should show the rest of the group the reason why that person is late for school. This can be done by using a word document and screenshare or by holding up a piece of paper with the reason on.

Once you are ready to play, the latecomer should face the screen and everyone should start acting out the reason for being late. The person who is late needs to try and work out what the group is acting out and provide the 'teacher' (leader) with the excuse before time runs out. Give 60 seconds for the latecomer to guess the correct excuse, otherwise they have been caught out for being late. Continue playing, with other children having a chance to be the latecomer.

Reasons for being late could include; abducted by aliens, chased by a dinosaur, pants caught fire, phone call from the queen, locked in the car, missed the bus, alarm didn't go off etc. The sillier the excuse the better!
