➔ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Explore why we praise God with music and then create your own worship band.

Hymns and worship songs are sung by Christians around the world. People sing hymns as a way of praising God and letting him know how much we love him. In the Bible it encourages us to praise God as loudly as we can.

'Praise him with trumpet blasts. Praise him with harps and lyres. Praise him with tambourines and dancing. Praise him with stringed instruments and flutes. Praise him with loud cymbals. Praise him with crashing cymbals. Let everything that breathes praise the Lord.' Psalm 150 v 3-6

As a large group, bring Psalm 150 to life... As loudly as you can. Encourage children to find a household item they can make music with. This might be a saucepan lid, frying pan, wooden spoon, tin cans to scrape, toilet roll tubes as trumpets, a tub of rice/pasta as shakers. Anything that makes a noise will work.

Play a worship song using screenshare and encourage the group to praise God with noise, just like Psalm 150 tell us to. As they play along, encourage them to also listen to the words of the song. Finish the activity in prayer, bringing your musical praise to God.
