VIRTUAL ROCK, PAPER, SCISSORS



➤ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Adapt a simple game of 'Rock, Paper, Scissors' into a virtual knockout tournament, with the aim of surviving for as long as possible.

To begin with, everyone plays rock, paper, scissors at the same time. For each game a 'leader' should be nominated. To begin with, this should be a leader until the game has been established. The aim of this version is not to necessarily win, but just to NOT get defeated by the person leading the game. Each round the children need to try and pick an item which won't get defeated by the leader's choice.

Play begins by saying 'one, two, three, shoot'. On 'shoot' everyone should reveal their chosen object (rock, paper or scissors). If the leader's choice beats yours, then all those children are out. It helps for those who are out to turn their camera off (they can still cheer for their friends). Continue playing rounds until the leader has defeated everyone playing. The aim of the game is to try and survive as many rounds as possible, without going out.

Play a new game, with everyone back in and a new leader. Who can set the record for surviving the most rounds?
