Activity (10 minutes)	3 INGREDIENT NUTELLA BROWNIES (Get Creative) Get the group to take on this simple baking challenge, with just 3 ingredients to mix up and put on a tray in the oven. Encourage the group to ask their parents/carers to share a photo of them enjoying their Nutella brownies. 	PAPER AEROPLANES (Get Creative) Children design a paper aeroplane, using materials they have at home. They can create their own design or you could share the instructional video for them to follow. Make sure you give the children encouragement throughout (even if you cannot quite see how they are doing!) Once you have given everyone time to make their plane ask them all to hold it up and show it to the camera and give an opportunity to fly it. 	TANGRAMS (Get Creative) Challenge the group to use just 7 colourful shapes to create a range of objects, animals and creations. By rearranging the shapes there are 100's of possibilities. This can be completed using the physical template or a virtual tangram maker. Devotions (10 minutes)	WISE & FOOLISH BUILDERS (Get Into the Bible) Use our video or your own equipment (2 x clear plastic crates, sand, brick, lego towers, water) to show the object lesson yourself. Encourage children to respond to the questions in the video with thumbs up/down, or if you are leading yourself ask the young people what they think will happen and ask questions throughout.
