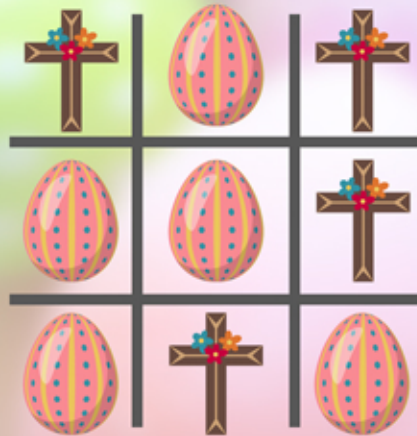

READY TO GO

EASTER NOUGHTS AND CROSSES



▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Play an Easter themed game of noughts and crosses, using easter objects and symbols instead.

For this game you'll need to download the PowerPoint for the game and share it via screenshare. To allow you to move the objects around on the screen leave the PowerPoint in edit mode, rather than sharing it as a presentation.

Split the group into two teams. Players on each team should take it in turns to decide where to place their team's object for each go. For example, if player one chooses where the first bunny goes, then player two should decide where the second bunny goes and so on. Continue playing, making sure all children have a go until you have a winner (three items in a row). Reset the game and then play another round.

To ensure children have as many goes as possible, consider splitting into breakout rooms to allow for smaller groups. Ensure you have two leaders in each breakout room.

Face-to-face / Alternative way of playing: Print out the template and cut out the individual shapes for players to place on the grid. If using a physical version virtually, then use a second device (phone) to show the game.
