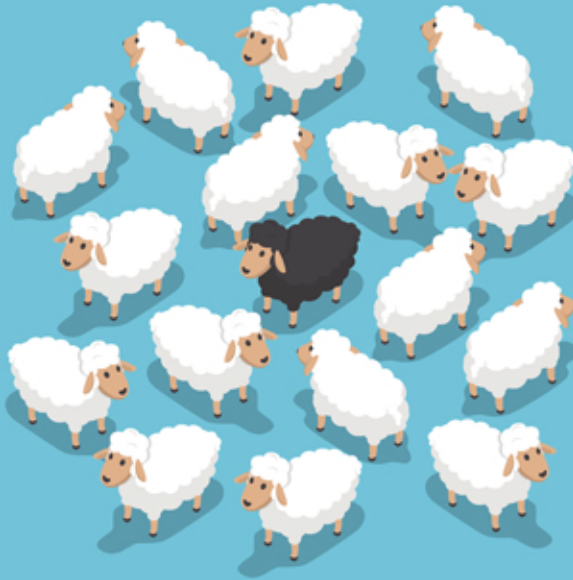

IMPOSTER



▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Amongst the group is a hidden imposter. Can the group uncover them or will you end up pointing the finger at the wrong person?

In this game, everyone is shown a theme. In turns each person should say one word associated with that theme. However, amongst the group is an imposter. They don't know the theme but still need to say a word to try and blend in. After everyone has said their word, the group should try to work out who the imposter is. A short period of questioning is allowed, before the group vote. Those who know the theme should try to keep their word vague enough that others know they aren't the imposter and not too specific that the real imposter will be able to guess the theme and say a word which makes them blend in.

How to Play: Everyone should face away from the screen. When their name is called, they can face the screen and read either the theme or the word 'imposter', depending on which slide you show them on the Imposter PowerPoint (via screenshare). Remove the PowerPoint and everyone can face the front again. A leader should call out the names of the group one by one for them to give their word. Make sure to not call out the imposter first, so not to make it too difficult. Alternatively, you could use the chat function to send the theme/imposter to members of the group.

Example Theme: Olympics. **Words:** Games, sports, Bolt, London, Tokyo, world, rings.
