LIP SYNC BATTLE



➔ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Bring out the hidden performers in your group by running a lip sync battle. Which legendary music stars will be visiting your meeting?

Lip sync battles are all about over the top performances to famous songs, whilst miming along to the words. Usually in a lip sync battle two or more people would perform, with the audience then voting for their winner. Encourage those taking part to really think about what they could do to make the performance as visual and funny as they possibly can. Costumes, props and family member backing dancers are highly encouraged. It's all about having fun and making others laugh. How to Do It: Give young people a weeks' notice, so they can think about what they would like to do and get any props together. Young people can share their music via screen share (advanced option, share computer sound only) and their video can be 'spotlighted', so they are the largest video when they perform. Not everyone may want to take part - that's fine. Try to encourage 2 or 3 young people to take part and the rest can then enjoy the show as the audience. It doesn't have to be the whole song, a short performance is fine too. Having leaders take part will help encourage young people to sign up!
