CHUBBY BUNNY

PART OF THE EASTER THEMED PROGRAMME



▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Use Easter and the Easter bunny as a great excuse to play the game 'Chubby Bunny'.

Play a game of 'chubby bunny', in honour of the Easter Bunny. In order to play this, children will need to have a bag of marshmallows. This could be done by asking families to buy a bag beforehand or by including marshmallows in any activity/care packs you may send to members.

The goal is for players to say the phrase "Chubby Bunny" with a mouthful of marshmallows so that others can understand what they are saying.

How to play: Participants take turns placing a marshmallow in their mouths and saying the phrase, "Chubby Bunny." Go around the group taking turns. Once everyone has said it with one marshmallow in their mouth, move on to two marshmallows and so on. Players who can no longer say the phrase intelligibly are eliminated after each round. The last player remaining is the winner.

Rules: If a player spits out a marshmallow, they are eliminated from the game. Players may not chew their marshmallows up, eat them, or swallow them whole. Players who do so are disqualified. Players may use fingers to rearrange the marshmallows in their mouths.



WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Bag of Marshmallows
- Bowl



KEEPING EVERYONE SAFE

Explain to the group that they must be sensible when playing. Ideally children should have a bowl ready to discard marshmallows if they need to. Marshmallows should be bagged and binned afterwards.
