GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Learn the international phonetic alphabet and then use it in practice as you try to identify the mystery objects.

The phonetic alphabet is used for lots of important things including by airlines, police, military and emergency services. It uses a set of 26 words to spell out the letters A-Z. All the words used are designed to sound distinct when spoken.

My Name: Use the phonetic alphabet sheet to spell out your name.

Mystery Object: A family member should grab a household item and hide it from you. You should try to guess what the object is by using the phonetic alphabet. To do this try to guess which letter the item begins with and then keep going, guessing the following letters until you think you know the object. Your family member might want to give you a clue to help.

Example - Teddy... Does it begin with Bravo? No... Does it begin with Echo? No... Does it begin with Tango? Yes... Is the second letter India? No... Is the second letter Echo? Yes... Is it a teddy? Yes.

Continue playing, taking it in turns to find the object or guess the letters.
