ACTIVITY	DESCRIPTION	RESOURCES
Arrival & Welcome	Welcome children to the session and have an arrival activity / game for them to take part in as they wait for everyone to arrive.	 Arrival game / activity (for inspiration check out the Programme Hub - https://boys-brigade.org.uk/programme-bb-leaders)
Game	LASER EYES (Get Active) A game which requires detective skills and stealth. Can the detective find 'laser eyes' before they manage to wipe out the group. Activity	FIRE LIGHTING (Get Adventurous) Learn a key survival skill by building and lighting a fire without the use of matches or a gas lighter. This activity uses a foil tray, cotton wool / sticks and a fire lighter.	 Fire Lighting Activity Card from Spring 2020. This card can be found online via OBM. Foil tray, fire striker, dry grass / cotton wool, dry sticks / wood, bucket of water
Drinks & Devotions	GET INTO THE BIBLE An opportunity for children to have a drink and for a leader to share a Bible story / devotion / thought for the day. Activity	TOASTING MARSHMALLOWS (Get Adventurous) Use the fire from earlier on in the session to now toast marshmallows with. Enjoy them as they are or create tasty s'mores with chocolate digestives. This activity could be expanded to create other campfire snacks too. ACTIVITY	DESCRIPTION	RESOURCES
Arrival & Welcome	Welcome children to the session and have an arrival activity / game for them to take part in as they wait for everyone to arrive.	 Arrival game / activity (for inspiration check out the Programme Hub - https://boys-brigade.org.uk/programme-bb-leaders)
Game	TRACKING (Get Adventurous) Be on the lookout for clues, as groups try to follow the trail of another group who are hiding in the trees. Take turns being the hiders and the hunters as groups develop their tracking skills. A great game to play in a forest / wood. Activity	BLINDFOLDED ROPE TRAIL (Get Adventurous) Challenge the group to work as a team to navigate a rope trail blindfolded. The ultimate test of teamwork, communication and using your senses. Drinks & Devotions	CREATION COLLAGE (Get Into the Bible) Whilst surrounded by nature, explore the story of creation and build a collage from natural objects to help visualise the story. Use this opportunity for children to also have a rest and a drink. Game	40-40 IN (Get Active) 40-40 in is a classic game designed to get children running around, hiding amongst the trees and using tactics to try and gain an advantage. Activity	VIP TRAIL (Get Adventurous) Become detectives and head out into your community on the hunt for clues to find a VIP. This activity requires a bit of planning beforehand by a leader, but it is well worth it. Groups are tasked with following a trail, looking high and low for clues. Only by following the clues and keeping on track, will they find out who the VIP is at the end of the trail. Aim to include a pocket park, play area or ice cream van on your route (or at the end of the route) to help make the activity even more fun. Activity	TREASURE HUNT (Get Adventurous) Whilst you might have walked around your local area hundreds of times, have you ever looked around to see all the little hidden everyday details? Set up a treasure hunt around the streets surrounding your meeting space and challenge groups to follow the instructions, solve the clues and find the treasure. If you don't wish to do a clues treasure hunt, then you could take on a photo treasure hunt instead. Aim to include a pocket park, play area or ice cream van on your route (or at the end of the route) to help make the activity even more fun. Activity	BUG HOTEL (Get Involved) Bugs play a huge role in keeping ecosystems alive. Help your ecosystem by creating a bug hotel - a safe place for bugs to rest and flourish. Create the bug hotels as a group and then encourage children to take them home and keep an eye on the bugs that visit.
