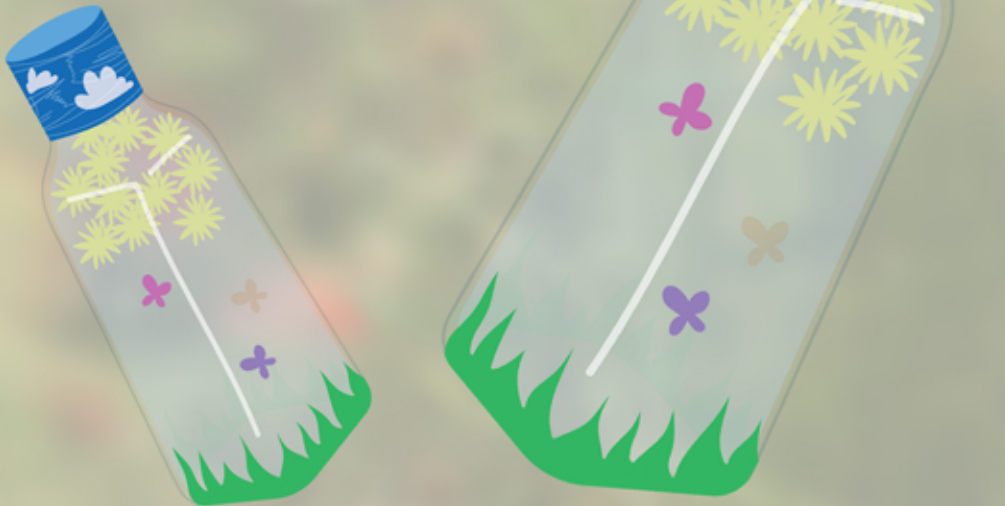

SPRING BOTTLES



▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Celebrate the colour and beauty of spring by creating a spring themed water globe.

Children will firstly need to head out to find pieces of nature that they would like to include in their spring bottle. This could include daisies, dandelions, petals, leaves etc. If you don't have any outside space local to your meeting location, then these items could be collected beforehand.

Remove any stems from the dandelions/daisies and place the spring items into the bottle. Other natural items such as feathers, small stones and sand could be added too. Add some glitter or confetti to the bottle to help make the bottles colourful and eye catching. Finally fill the bottle with water and place the lid on top. The outside of the bottle could also be decorated with stickers.

Once complete, give the bottle a shake and see how the flowers, glitter and other objects swirl around. Compare children's spring bottles and spend some time taking about the season of Spring and what happens in the natural world around us during the season.

- Glitter / Confetti
- Stickers / Craft Materials
- Water
