

THERE'S BEEN A MURDER!

A body has been discovered and there are 10 possible suspects. The clues have been spread out across the UK and we need your detective skills to hunt down the evidence, eliminate suspects and find the culprit. You'll need to be quick though, we have multiple detective teams working on this case and only the first team to find the murderer will get the credit. There's no time to waste!

How to Solve the Case?

There are 9 clues, each one will eliminate one of the suspects, leaving just the guilty party on the suspects list - case solved! The clues provide UK postcodes, which you'll need to use to find the evidence. Enter the postcode in Google Maps and use street view to get onto the ground and looking for clues. You may need to move up and down the street in order to find what you are looking for. Remember you are working as a team, so use screenshare (virtual session) or a large screen / projector (face-to-face), so everyone can help hunt for clues.

All the streets you'll be visiting have a Boys' Brigade connection, so you'll need to use your BB knowledge to help make sure you are looking on the correct streets.

Time how long it takes to crack the case and submit your results to BBHQ. Time starts when you type in the first postcode and finishes when you've found the murderer. Only the quickest detective team will get the credit they deserve, so there's no time to waste. Go!

CLUE 1: CM2 0JY

We're starting on a street which shouldn't be drifting anywhere anytime soon. Look at both ends of the street. You'll find one of our suspects has a matching surname to a local business. They can be crossed off our list.

Clue 2: ML1 2AR

Head out of Flemington Street and left onto Orbiston Street. You'll find an anchor on your right - keep going until you hit the transport services on the right. These initials will help you to cross off another suspect.

Clue 3: KT5 8QT

Take a look up the street that bears the name of our founder. Chained to a lamp post is an item not found near the murder scene. Any suspect with a similar sounding name to this object can be eliminated.

Clue 4: HP3 0BB

Carefully head up the hill until you find a familiar looking logo. At the bottom of this sign is a clue that 'points' us in the right direction to eliminating another suspect. You can cross off this person from our list.

Clue 5: NN5 5BN

Walk up the street named after the city we were founded in. At the top of the street, you'll need to look up high for this next clue. A suspect with connections to these initials can be cleared from your enquires.

Clue 6: SA11 4HT

This street must be full of 11-15 year olds. This next clue might seem like a load of rubbish, but it's exactly what we need. Find the clue, match the name and cross off this person from your line of enquires.

Clue 7: CH7 4RB

Walk up the street named after our Patron. To eliminate the next suspect, we'll need to travel back to 1908. Find the year and you'll see to a clue to the left which can be used to identify another innocent person.

Clue 8: BT26 6HH

Our next clue can be found outside the Boys' Brigade's Northern Ireland HQ. One of the vehicles driving past can be linked to one of our suspects. Their alibi is rock solid. Eliminate them from your enquiries.

TOP SECRET

Clue 9: KT1 1PL

We have one last bridge to cross before we solve the case. Make 'Sure' to zoom in first to find the correct street to head down. Take a look around for one last sign to show you which person can be taken off the suspect list.

CASE SOLVED!

You should have eliminated 9 suspects, leaving just the murderer remaining. Great job!

Don't forget to let us know who the murderer is and how quickly you cracked the case.
