# PUTTING

## GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Create a golf hole from a tin can and then design your own putting greens to play on.

Putting the ball into the hole requires patience and skill. Help to develop those skills by creating an easy to use golf hole that you can use pretty much anywhere.

**Tin Can Golf Hole:** Take an old tin can and ensure it is clean and any sharp edges have been smoothed out. Glue / tape a lolly stick to the back of the can and then cut out a small triangle shape from a piece of card. Attach the triangle card to the top of the lolly stick to create a flag. If you want to go even further then you could paint and design the tin can, to make it look good.

**Putting:** Lay your tin can golf hole at one end of the playing area and decide where you are going to start your putting from. You can make the putting green more difficult by adding obstacles in the way (Jenga blocks, planks of wood, games equipment etc). What is the best score you can get on your putting green?

**Competition:** Take turns trying out each other's putting greens. Keep a score on each hole and see who has the lowest score once everyone has played all the holes.



## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Tin Can
- Lolly Stick, Card & Scissors
- Tape / Glue
- Golf Ball & Putter (or similar)
- Obstacles
