GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

There are 195 countries in the world, each one having its own flag. Take a look at some of these flags and have a go at recreating them and designing your own.

To help run this activity, it would be good to have some examples of world flags for the group to look at.

Biscuit Flags: Use biscuits, icing and coloured sweets to create some edible world flags. Which flags can be created using the colours from a packet of smarties or M&Ms?

Giant Object Flags: Recreate world flags using everyday items. This might be equipment found in the games and craft cupboards (face-to-face) or coloured items found around the home (virtual). Lay the items on the floor, grouping the same coloured items together to create a recognisable flag.

Design Your Own Flag: Use the template sheet or a blank piece of paper. Come up with a design for your own flag. This could be for a made-up country or for the country where you live. Think about what patterns, symbols and colours you might use. Once everyone has designed their flag, spend some time showing them to the group and explaining a little bit about the design.
