## PHOTO CHALLENGE

There are 10 photo challenges for the team to complete en-route. Some of the challenges require one or more of the team members to be creative and find a way to appear that they are carrying out some type of task. Others require the team to take a photo of a particular object. At least one team member must be in every photo. Only photos taken during the walk can be counted for the competition.

### Equipment

A suitable device on which to take photos. The photos must be viewable at the end of the walk by a staff member to calculate the points.

### Photos

- 1) A team member with a public telephone
- 2) A member of your team walking on water
- 3) A member of your team flying
- 4) A photo with the name of a team member (first or last name) in it - and the team member in the photo
- 5) A team member with a post box
- 6) A team member in a photo with a Union Jack flag
- 7) Your team's reflection in something other than a mirror (all team members must be in the photo - one team member can be missing if taking the photo)
- 8) A team member on a bridge
- 9) A member of your team following the instructions on a sign
- 10) A team member with a public footpath sign

### Risks

- Team members should be briefed:
  - not to take unnecessary risk in completing the challenges
  - not to enter private land without consent
- Staff should consider and plan how team members are to show the photos to the staff member upon completion of the walk. Any sharing of photos via airdrop/messaging services or similar must be done in a manner that complies with your organisation's safeguarding policy if the photos are taken on a device owned by a person under the age of 18.

### Scoring

One point should be awarded for each challenge successfully completed. A point should only be awarded if the required team members are in the photo.
