GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Write a letter on behalf of the world, asking someone in power to help protect the world for future generations. A Christian Aid appeal, linked to Christian Aid Week, 10th - 16th May 2021.

'Letters for the World' is a Christian Aid project for children and young people who are passionate about climate change and climate justice, and want to do something about it. This activity encourages children to write a letter or send a message to someone in power (i.e. a politician) asking them to take action to protect the world.

My Future World is in Your Hands: Use the 'My Future World' template sheet. This says 'My Future World is in Your Hands'. Encourage children to colour in the world and add pictures around the outside of things which they would like to see protected for their future world. We've included some examples but children are encouraged to draw their own items too. This template also has an 'our future world' version if children would like to work together.

Large Collage: Take the concept and make it super-size! Create a giant group collage on a large sheet of paper / display board / sheet. Bring all your creations together to make a big impact.

Once the letters are finished, don't forget to sign them and then send them (physically or electronically) to the person you've chosen. You could also include a written letter too. Don't forget to ask for a reply and share on social media too.
